

A LETTER from Reverend BEN STRENGTH, our New Pastor

"I know two things of importance which I want to communicate to all who read this message – YOU need the Church and your Church needs YOU!"

Grace and Peace to you from the Lord Jesus Christ! I am excited about this appointment to Monticello First United Methodist Church. Monticello is not exactly new to me – I taught U. S. History, Gifted classes and Advanced Placement classes at Monticello High School from 1978 to 2008. My family, Barbara, Jim and Karl began living in our place on Goolsby Road in 1991. Jasper County and Monticello are home to us. It was an honor and an unexpected pleasure to be appointed to serve the church and community in Monticello.

I have been a United Methodist minister under appointment since 1970. I had decided to fully retire after serving the Philadelphia – St. Paul United Methodist appointment, in Putnam County, for forty-one years. I believed that after forty-one years with them and fifty-two years under appointment that it was time for me to fully retire. However, an unexpected thing happened on the way to full retirement. God began to indicate to me that He was not finished with me – that there was something else He wanted me to do in His service.

My phone rang one day and your chairman of the SPRC committee, Matt Kelly, told me that the committee and some people in First United Methodist Church of Monticello would like me to consider coming to the church as part-time pastor in charge for the 2022-23 conference year. For me to say that this was a surprise to me would be a serious understatement. I thought and prayed about this opportunity for a few days. I also discussed it with my wife (Barbara) and with my sons (Jim and Karl) and our District Superintendent (Susan Gary Landry). I decided to accept the appointment out of the conviction that this was God's will for me at this time in my life.

I come to your church with a deep sense of commitment to Christ and to the people of Monticello First United Methodist Church. I know that the last two years have been a real trial for all churches. Covid 19 and all of the challenges it has presented have had a serious and negative impact on all aspects of our lives. If this covid plague wasn't enough for us to deal with as individuals, families, communities and churches, we also have serious issues in our society which tend to divide us. I believe we have had too much negativity in our lives, communities, and our churches. What we need now is something and someone positive in our lives.

What we need is Jesus! We need to hear the gospel of God's love, mercy, forgiveness, peace and healing.
